Instructions for receiving occupational accident labor

equipment subsidy :

1. Eligibility: A worker must use an assistive device due to an occupational injury or illness that has been diagnosed by a doctor or assessed by other professionals, and has not received the same item of device subsidies or benefits in accordance with the Occupational Accident Labor Protection Act, the Labor Occupational Accident Insurance and Protection Act, or other laws and regulations.

2. The subsidy standard:
