## Instructions for receiving occupational accident labor equipment subsidy :

1. **Eligibility :** A worker must use an assistive device due to an occupational injury or illness that has been diagnosed by a doctor or assessed by other professionals, and has not received the same item of device subsidies or benefits in accordance with the Occupational Accident Labor Protection Act, the Labor Occupational Accident Insurance and Protection Act, or other laws and regulations.

2. **The subsidy standard :**

Occupational Accident Labor Protection Act Appliance subsidy	<p>1. Appliances according to the standard table of subsidy for labor aids in occupational accidents and the amount of the subsidy.</p> <p>2. Four assistive devices are subsidized each year, and the total amount of subsidy is limited to NT\$60,000.</p> <p>(Except artificial electronic ear, Braille touch monitor and desktop TV expansion machine)</p> <p>3. Those who have been approved by the Department to subsidize the assembly of assistive devices will exceed the minimum service life</p> <p>After that, if it is still necessary to use it after being diagnosed by a doctor, it is necessary to apply again for the same item.</p>
Labor Occupational Accident Insurance and Protection Act Appliance subsidy	<p>1. The items of assistive devices and the amount of subsidy stipulated in the appendix of Article 3 of the Regulations on Subsidy for Device Care Disability and Death Subsidy for Workers with Occupational Accidents.</p> <p>2. Except for artificial electronic ear, each person can subsidize up to 4 assistive devices per year, and the total amount of subsidy is limited to NT\$100,000.</p> <p>3. Those who have been approved by the Department for subsidizing the assembly of assistive devices may reapply for the same item after the minimum service life has been exceeded, if the doctor still diagnoses the need for use.</p>
